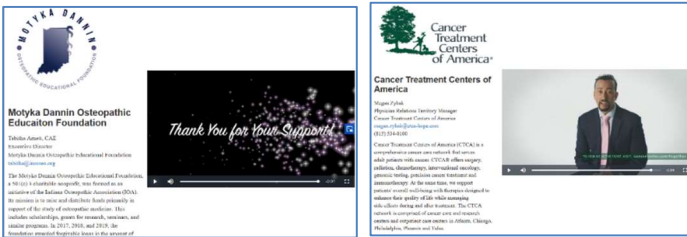
Registration: All vendors are required to register online at www.ioms.org. Payment can be made online with a credit card or by mailing in a check. Indicate payment method at bottom of registration form.

Cost: \$550 (make checks payable to “Illinois Osteopathic Medical Society”). The Virtual Winter Scientific Update will have more exposure for all exhibitors since the Virtual Exhibit page will be available to attendees before, during, and following the conference. The \$550 fee covers the virtual/online exhibit platform.

Virtual Exhibit Page/Layout: Virtual Exhibitors may send their company logo, name, contact information, and a brief paragraph that promotes the company product or mission. Virtual Exhibits will have a dedicated page on the Virtual Conference website.

Virtual Exhibit Video (optional): Virtual Exhibitors may also upload a promotion video (recommended no more than 30-seconds).

Live Interactive Options: Vendors may choose to create their own live interactive experience by providing us with a link to include in the paragraph on the vendor page. While we cannot guarantee registrants will enter the Live Interactive room/link that vendors may provide, the option to include this link is included at no additional charge.

Exhibit Hours:

Virtual Exhibits will be available before/during/after the Conference to all attendees/registrants. Scheduled breaks will allow time for attendees to visit the virtual exhibit hall. Reminders will be shared during breaks to encourage attendees to visit the Virtual Exhibit tab on the conference page.

Friday Virtual Networking Reception:

Contact the IOMS for more information about sponsoring the Friday Virtual Networking Reception through live video conference with attendees.

Attendance: An estimated 70-100 Osteopathic Physicians (from all specialties with a majority practicing primary care disciplines) from throughout Illinois and surrounding states.

Cancellation & Refund Policy: Virtual Exhibits cancelled more than 7 days prior to the conference date will incur a 25% administrative fee of the total cost. Cancellations made with less than 7 days' notice will not be refunded and all contracted space for balance must be paid in full. All incurred charges and unpaid balances are due at the time of cancellation.

Security & Liability:

The Illinois Osteopathic Medical Society (hereafter IOMS) shall not be liable for any damage, injury, or loss caused to an exhibitor of his/her property, or the property of his/her company occasioned by the condition of the premises or its mechanical systems, loss by theft, mysterious disappearance or damage by fire, accident, or any other cause; or any other act or omission of IOMS or any of its officers, agenda, and employees; or any damage or injury arising from any act, omission or negligence of said IOMS or its officers, agents, employees, except for damage, injury or loss that arises from the negligence of willful misconduct of IOMS or its officers, agents, or employees.

Insurance: It shall be the responsibility of each exhibitor to maintain such insurance against injury to the person or damage or loss to property in such amounts as the exhibitor shall deem adequate. Insurance protection will not be afforded to the exhibitor by IOMS.

Conducting Exhibits: All exhibits must conform to the fire laws, health regulations, electrical codes and other ordinances of the local municipality. Conduct of the exhibits is subject to IOMS approval. The IOMS reserves the right to approve the character of any exhibit and to prohibit any display which is the cause of noise or has other objectionable features that may detract from the general character of the exhibits. This applies to display literature, advertising novelties, souvenirs, conduct of persons, etc.

Rules: In the event of IOMS' failure or inability to fulfill this contract due to conditions or reasons beyond its control, IOMS agrees to return to the exhibitor all deposits made, and this agreement shall be deemed cancelled by mutual consent; and exhibitor agrees to accept such return of deposits as full and final settlement of any and all claims relating thereto.

The exhibitor hereby agrees to release IOMS and its employees, representatives, agents, successors, and assignees from any and all damages, claims, judgements, losses, costs and expenses, including but not limited to attorney's' fees, that may hereafter at any time be incurred or imposed upon them, or be made a party to, or be required to pay, do or perform by reason of, arising out of, or by virtue of, or incident to, the performance of any contract or agreement which may result in acceptance of this application or the providing of exhibits pace, including but not limited to any such claims, damages, losses, or expenses attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease, death, or to injury to or destruction of tangible personal property including the loss of use resulting there from, provided that the foregoing shall not apply to damages, claims, judgements, losses, cost, or expenses that arise from the negligence or willful misconduct of IOMS and/or its employees, representatives, agents, successors or assignees.

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
